INTERIOR HAZARDS	AFFECTS	ACTION REQUIRED TO REDUCE RISKS
Wood burning stove	All	When lighting/stoking fire check fire guard is hooked in place
Burns		Adult to stand/sit near stove when activities/games taking place
Sparks		Young people not to go near fire during 'clue finding' activities
Falling logs etc		Fire door to be fully closed and latched when fire is lit
		Stove door and all vents to be closed before vacating building
Electric radiators	All	Radiator guard to be in place at all times
Burns		Nothing to be placed on top of radiator guards at any time
Fire		Do not sit or lean on radiator guards
Drawing pins	All	Pins seen on floor to be picked up immediately
 Injury from loose pins 		Only drawing pins (not map pins) to be used on notice boards
Benches/tables	All	Benches not to be folded and stacked no more than three high with legs downwards
Injury from tipping		Tables to be stacked together at end of hall facing resource cupboard
Injury from closing legs		Table legs to be folded by holding at waist level for unlocking legs
Kitchen	All	Young people not allowed in kitchen unsupervised
Burns from hot liquids/appliances		Cooker, kettle, boiler & microwaves to be supervised when in use or hot
Hazardous substances (eg bleach)		All appliances to be switched off/unplugged when not in use
Sharp knives		Cleaning materials and hazardous liquids to be stored above head height
		All sharp knives to be kept in red storage box in exterior store
Fire & Carbon monoxide	All	Smoke alarm and CO alarm to be tested before lighting stove
Hut may easily catch fire		Smoke alarm and CO alarm to be tested before sleeping in Hut overnight
Incorrect use of fire produces CO		All four exterior doors to be checked and not to be bolted when Hut in use
		Fire extinguishers tested annually
		No naked flames allowed inside Hut
		No flammable or combustible substances (eh meths, petrol) permitted in the Hut
		Firelighters and matches/lighters to be kept in separate fireproof containers
Sharp objects	Young members	Sharp pointed scissors & other objects to be kept in Leaders' desk; only round ended
Careless use causing injury		scissors allowed in craft boxes
Dust	All	Floor to be vacuumed, not swept
May cause allergic reactions		Brushing to clear larger items to be completed carefully so as not to raise dust
 Dust in radiators may cause fire

Road Danger from passing vehicles Parked vehicles obstructing road Lights from parked vehicles Vehicles manoeuvring in gateway Vehicles on site Danger from moving vehicles	All	 Keep gate closed during all exterior activities Hand over Beavers to parents/guardians at end of sessions Young people only allowed outside gate after collection by parent/guardian All parents to be frequently reminded to turn off headlights when parked Turning and manoeuvring in gateway prohibited at all times 5 mph speed limit on site No vehicles permitted in front of or to right of building Only Leaders' and Parent Helpers' vehicles allowed inside gateway No vehicles on site to be moved during sessions
Tripping hazards • Man hole covers	All	 Vehicles to be parked on left boundary facing outwards; no vehicles to reverse while young people on site without direction from outside vehicle Man hole cover in front of exterior sink – one adult or non-player to be placed on guard during exterior activities to prevent tripping
 Man hole covers Tree roots Rabbit holes Exterior steps	All	 Young people to be instructed not to run in the dark Young people to be warned against running unless they can see their footfall is clear Exterior light to be switched on before the start of any session finishing after dark
Falling down stepsSteep dropsQuarry/shooting range	All	 Young people to be prevented from crowding on exiting the Hut All steep drops and banks are Out of Bounds for safety & to prevent erosion All Young people to be warned not to cross boundary tapes or to run in the dark
 Steep banks Barbed wire fences Cuts & danger to eyes Missing persons 	All Young people	 All to be shown boundaries on first joining All to be warned that site boundary is a barbed wire fence All to be shown boundaries on first joining All to be recorded on register at start of each session
Stranger dangerGetting lost	Tourig people	 All to be recorded on register at start or each session All to be recorded back into Hut at end of each outdoor session All to be counted after any pause/halt during any outdoor activity All to be asked to report any strangers on site including in the woodland
Cargo net Danger of falling or getting trapped in ropes	Young people	 Young people to be supervised while playing on cargo net To be out of bounds during darkness hours
Activity Specific HazardsShooting, Hiking, Forestry, Axes & saws	All	Activity specific risk assessments apply
Camp fire area • Fire		 Hosepipe to be connected and on hand OR fire extinguishers & full buckets of water to be on hand before lighting fires outside the Hut No fires to be lit during dry weather period Campfires to be restricted to the campfire area within a footprint of 12 sq ft, flames not to exceed 3 ft high and no accelerants to be used Fires lit in half-drums to be at least 3m from buildings, tents and any other flammable materials, flame height no to exceed 3 ft and no accelerants to be used. All firewood brought onto site to be de-nailed and stored in safe location
